



5 ELEMENTS OF GOOD DESIGN

- **Visual Flow**

- Consistency – page to page
- Symmetry works good (equal amounts of graphics and white space)
- Easy to follow and read!

- **Color**

- Color can set a mood
- Use Black, white and Gray as your base
- Add colors that complement and contrast
- A splash of bright color can add interest
- Limit to two colors plus black & White!

- **White Space**

- Blank space on your page
- Literally not “White”
- Makes sites attractive and easy to read.

- **Typography**

- Use an easily readable font (Times New Roman, San Serif)
- Fonts with tails are easier to read
- Unusually fonts will not always come through on Grandma’s Computer

- **Writing Clear and Concise**

- Reading on the monitor is hard
- Tell your story concisely
- Break up text into 4-5 sentence chunks
- Don’t let text go all the way across the page.
