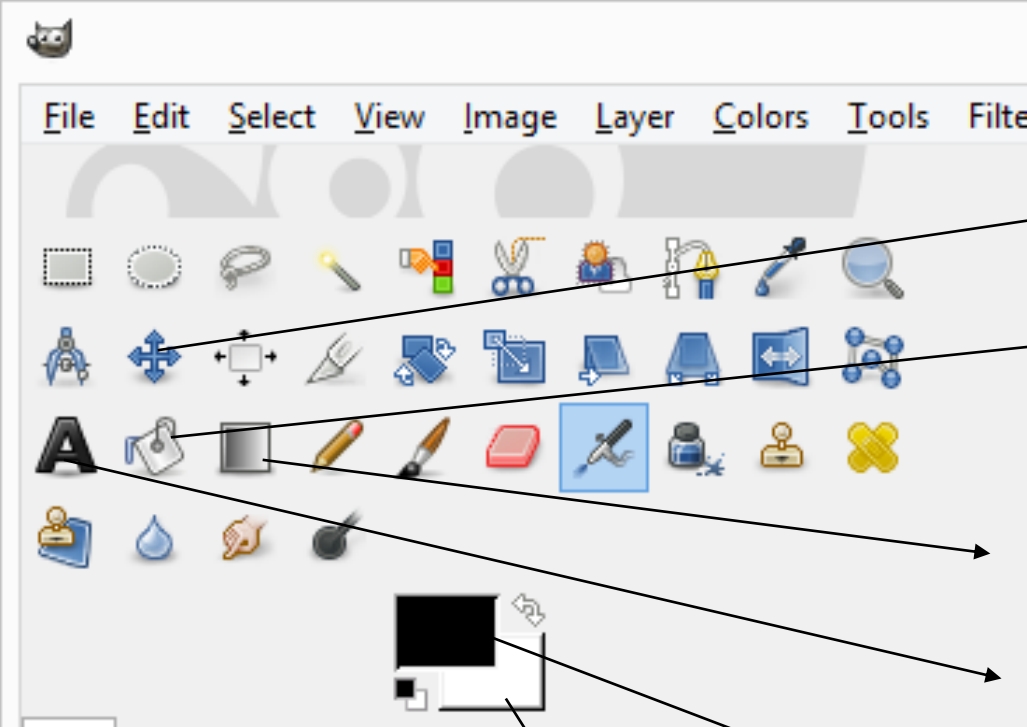

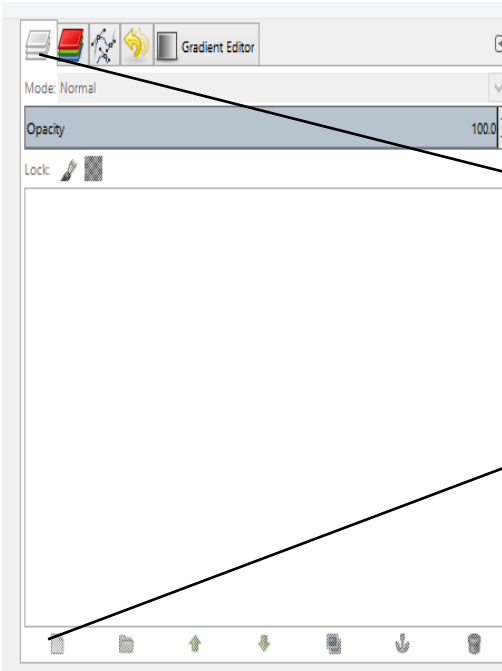

GIMP NOTES

What are the steps for creating a text border?

1. Add a new Layer - Name it (Text Border).
2. Move the Text Border underneath the Text Layer.
3. On the Text Layer, Right Click - Alpha to Selection
4. Go to the Select Menu - GROW (2-6 Pixels)
5. Move to the TEXT BORDER LAYER
6. Bucket Fill - Select the desired foreground color.
7. Turn off the dancing ants (SELECT Menu - NONE)

How do you add a drop shadow to your text border?

1. Make sure you are on the Text Border Layer
2. Go to the FILTERS menu
3. Select "Light & Shadow"
4. Select "Drop Shadow"
5. Find the Gold GIMP GUY at the bottom of your screen - Click on him
6. Un-Check the Re-Sizing box
7. Select your desired shadow.

How do you make your Gimp project a JPEG format?

1. Always save the completed project as a XCF file!!!!
2. Select the FILE menu
3. Choose EXPORT
4. Make sure you are in your Z: Drive (your name)
5. At the bottom of screen, click on "File Type by Extension"
6. Choose JPEG image
7. Menu box will pop up - Click Export
