





STEP-BY-STEP

Making a Sandwich Notecard in Evernote

- 1. Log in to Evernote
- 2. Go to Mel.org (Databases) to search for evidence.
 - Opposing Viewpoints
 - Academic One
 - General One
 - Research in Context
- 3. Use the Web Clipper to CLIP the article
 - Article ++ to include CITATION
 - Select the desired notebook
 - Tag it!
 - Click Save
- 4. Return to Evernote Refresh
 - Open the card (Make sure it is in the correct notebook & clipped correctly)
- 5. Copy your SOURCE CITATION to the TOP of the NOTE
- 6. Add the #3, #4, #5 place holders above the source citation
- 7. Find EVIDENCE you can use in the Article (#4)
 - Locate the sentence
 - Highlight and copy it to the #4 spot
 - Add " " marks around the sentence (remove the period)
 - Add the Parenthetical Citation (period at the end)
 - ◆ Strike-out a portion of the sentence & paraphrase (This is your INTRO) it is one sentence!
 - ♦ Add back in the missing " at the start of your quote.
- 8. Add #3 The Claim (Opinion + Fact) that relates to the evidence.
- 9. Write a commentary #5
 - Commentary re-states the claim
 - Opinion + Fact
- 10. Number your Notecard (Green Title #1)
